## FTK-Centre for Information Technology – A Brief Background

Established in 1984 as a Computer Centre with the objective of providing central computing facility to the students and staff of the University, it took more than fifteen years to transform it to a full-fledged Information Centre for Technology with the latest ICT facilities and services. Ever since its inception, the Centre has played pivotal role in developing and implementing IT services and applications in Jamia. To offer IT services to the end users in the University, it has established a campus wide network of 2700 nodes. In addition, for easy access to applications and services, the CIT has setup a number of WiFi hotspots within the University Campus. The CIT is also responsible for development and implementation of University Management Information System. Presently, the University ERP consists of 18 modules and is being extensively used in the day-today activities of the University. In addition, the Centre manages the University website, E-Mailing system and other useful Intranet services. The Centre is continuously striving to bridge the gap between the IT and the end users for optimum utilization of the IT resources. To achieve this endeavor, it continuously arranges various IT training programs, extension lectures and workshops for its users.

#### Objective

There has been an exponential growth of IT Services in Indian Universities. At present, most of the universities have their own campus area networks, websites, management information systems, e-governance facilities, and activities related to e-Leaning. Such milestones, in the path of rapid development, have been achieved due to highly ITskilled manpower working in the universities. During the last ten years, there have been enormous developments in Information

Communication Technology (ICT) and its effects are visible everywhere. The growth of skilled IT professionals in universities, however, does not match with the fast growth of IT and there is a need to have a microscopic look on the entire IT scenario in educational institutions in the country. Also, due to lack of coordination among the IT Centres in the universities, it has not been possible to share the information about development in these institutions and also about the experiences of the IT staff in the implementation of IT projects in the respective universities. Likewise, no effort appears to been directed have sustainable IT development in the institutions of higher learning in the country. Computer staff in IT centres have been facing the dilemma that till the X plan period they were neither clubbed with the academic staff nor with the scientific staff, in spite of the fact that they train the trainers and also involved themselves in research & development.

The conference on "Sustainable Development and Management of Information Technology in Universities and Colleges" (SUDMIT 2009) has been planned to take stock of what has been achieved so far in implementing IT in Indian universities, to showcase best practices in IT Management in the University IT Centers, and to set the course for the sustainable development of Information Technology.

The event will also provide the IT Professionals of the universities an opportunity to interact among themselves for sharing their experience, knowledge and expertise and also to share and discuss their problems. It will also serve as a technical forum for providing guidelines to the Government in the formulation and implementation of a suitable model for sustainable development of IT in universities and its efficient management, including sustainable growth of IT Professionals whose retention is extremely important for the development of the academic institutions
