Chinmaya Lal Thakur is an Assistant Professor of English at Shiv Nadar University (Institution of Eminence), Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh. He earned his Ph.D. at La Trobe University in Melbourne, Australia, for his study of the representation of subjectivity in the novels of David Malouf. His academic interests include postcolonial literatures and cultures, modernist writings, the contemporary novel, modern Indian intellectual history, and Continental Philosophy. Chinmaya understands his research interest to be located at the intersection of postcolonial studies, Deconstruction, and modernist writing.
