

Dr. Raj Kumar is a Professor in the Department of English, Delhi University. His research areas include Autobiographical studies, Dalit literature, Indian writing in English, Odia literature and Post-Colonial Studies. He has been a Fellow at the Indian Institute of Advanced Study, Shimla in 1999 and has been published in a number of reputed and scholarly journals such as Social Action, Sateertha Bulletin, The Fourth World, Creative Forum, Language Forum, Jadavpur Journal of Comparative Literature, Indian Literature, Social Scientist and others.

Professor Raj Kumar has also translated literary texts from Indian languages, especially Odia into English. His book, Dalit Personal Narratives: Reading Caste, Nation and Identity has been published by Orient BlackSwan, New Delhi in 2010 and got reprinted in 2011, 2015 and 2017. His English translation of Akhila Naik's Bheda, the first Odia Dalit novel is published by Oxford University Press, Delhi in 2017. His book Dalit Literature and Criticism is published by Orient
