In India he has designed the award-winning Nirlon Knowledge Park on old industrial land in Mumbai. At present he is working on two major assignments, both on old industrial lands in Vadodara and Bangalore where he has been working for more than 7 years. Formerly Director of BDP.Khandekar, since 2012 he is working on projects via his Netherlands-based consultancy ICONS/NL.

He is also the Co-founder and Director of the international knowledge platform MY LIVEABLE CITY and co-author of books AFFORDABLE HOUSING & INCLUSIVE CITIES (2015) and DESIGNING FOR SUSTAINABILITY THROUGH UPCYCLING (2019).
