Introduction:

The workshop will make the participants understand the ontological and epistemological concerns regarding Communication as a field of enquiry and discipline. It will also address media's engagement in the field of culture, which itself is increasingly getting interdisciplinary though it may have anthropological origins. Media flows and mediated practices have led to looking at 'media' and 'culture' not as exclusive terms but as intersecting usage. Thus culture is no longer a mere anthropological claim, but it has received renewed meanings by adding prefix and suffix to the term such as mass culture and popular culture. Much has happened in the areas of media's relation with democracy. The past seven decades have shown tremendous democratic vibrancy along with media expansion. It is equally important to explore in what way such changes have afflicted our understanding of media pluralism and diversity.

Objectives:

1. To address the state of communication research and its historical trajectory.
2. To explore the linkage between communication and culture of how media's engagement in the field of culture, which is increasingly getting interdisciplinary though it may have anthropological origins.
3. To highlight the relationship between media and governance on how decision-making processes and framing policies that impact the media landscape as influenced by different stakeholders.
