In this study researcher has observed various aspects of parent-teacher partnership at government primary schools in Lucknow city and also tried to understand the link between this partnership and students' performance. At present it is not very easy to maintain home – school partnership without any hurdles and it is a very challenging task for teachers as well as parents to shape meaningful and sensible partnership between them. Descriptive research study design was used for the research study. Mixed research method was used to carry out this research, both qualitative and quantitative methods were used by researcher to understand the form and challenges of partnership between parents and teachers in primary schools.
