Pass Percentage and Promotion of Candidates:

- 8.1. A student of 1st semester who is detained due to shortage of attendance will not be permitted to appear in the examination. However, he/she may be re-admitted next year in the 1st semester.
- 8.2. The pass percentage for Internal Assessment as well as for End-Semester Examination shall be 50% seParately for each of these components and shall be applicable to each theory paper/laboratory/ practical/ field work/ teaching practice etc., wherever applicable.
- 8.3. A student will automatically be promoted from the first semester to the second semester, provided that he/she has fulfilled the minimum requirement of attendance.
- 8.4. A student who failed in the 1st and 2nd semester examinations or could not appear in the 2nd semester examination for reasons other than shortage of attendance will not be readmitted. However, he/she may be allowed to reappear as an ex-student in the next semester examination.

 8.5. A student of 2nd semester who has not taken
- examinations due to shortage of attendance may be given re-admission in the consecutive concerned semester of the programme. In case, he/she fails to fulfil the requirement of attendance after being given re-admission, his/her admission shall stand cancelled.
- 8.6. No candidate shall be permitted to move to the third semester if he/she has a backlog of more than 25% of the courses of the first and second semesters combined. However, such a student may appear as an ex-student in the ensuing semester examinations. Such a student will be required to appear only in such papers in which he/she has failed.
- 8.7. The maximum period during which a candidate shall have to pass all the papers of the 1st and 2nd semesters is four semesters (two academic years), failing which his/her admission will be cancelled.
