Ordinance 15 (XV) [academic] "The University Examinations; General Guidelines"

1.3	Private Candidates: The following categories of candidates may be permitted by the Majlis-i- Talimi (Academic Council) to appear as Private Candidates at the University Examinations: • Women, • Permanent Teachers and other Employees of Jamia Millia Islamia, • Defence personnel in uniform, • Urdu Medium candidates; and • Physically handicapped candidates. Provided that no permission shall be given to appear at the examination as a Private Candidate in a professional course or in a course for which a practical examination/field work prescribed. The candidates shall be required to fulfill the following requirements as mentioned under each Category:	Private Candidates: The following categories of candidates may be permitted by the Majlis-i- Talimi (Academic Council) to appear as Private Candidates at the University Examinations: • Women, • Permanent Teachers and other Employees of Jamia Millia Islamia, • Defence personnel in uniform, • Urdu Medium candidates; and • Physically handicapped candidates. Provided that no male applicants will be allowed to appear as Private candidate in Class X and XII Examinations under the "Urdu Medium candidates" except the Madrasa students whose degree is recognized by Jamia Millia Islamia for having passed the examination in English of Sr. School Certificate separately for admitting to B.A. (Pass/Hons.) 1st year courses in Jamia Millia Islamia. Provided further that no permission shall be given to appear at the examination as a Private Candidate in a course for which a practical examination/field work/teaching practice/outdoor practice is prescribed as a part of the curriculum. The candidates shall be required to fulfill the following requirements as mentioned under each Category:
