6.4	In a programme of three or more semesters duration, a student will automatically be promoted from the odd semester to the even semester, provided that he/she has fulfilled the minimum requirement of attendance and field work wherever applicable, failing which he/she may be permitted to appear as an ex-student in the next odd/even semester examination, as the case may be. In a two-semester programme, a student of the first semester shall have to fulfill the minimum requirement of attendance and Internal Assessment, and obtain passing grades in at least 50% of the courses in the Semester-end Examination, failing which his/her admission shall stand cancelled. However, such a student may be given re-admission in the same semester in the next year as per the provisions of Ordinance 5 (V) (Academic).
