Fellowships, Scholarships and Gold Medals for Students**

Existing Ordinance	Amended
<p>5. Leave Entitlement for UGC JRF/SRF/Non-NET Fellows</p> <p>5.2. Women awardees will be eligible for "maternity leave" for 180 days at full rates of the fellowship once during the tenure of their award. Besides this, an 'Intermittent Break' for a maximum period of two years may also be permissible to the women candidates. This Flexi-time period shall not be counted towards the tenure of the fellowship and thus effectively the total period of the fellowship shall remain the same.</p>	<p>5. Leave Entitlement for UGC JRF/SRF/Non-NET Fellows</p> <p>5.2. Women awardees will be eligible for "maternity leave" for 240 days at full rates of fellowship shall remain the same.</p> <p>The women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of M.Phil/Ph.D. for up to 240 days. The women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of one year for M.Phil and two years for Ph.D. in the maximum duration.</p>
