



The library has fully computerised its most actively used collection, which is now available to users through OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) with network access across the campus.

FMS Library

The FMS library is equipped with a diverse collection of books and business journals to keep the students updated and well informed with the latest developments and changes in the corporate world.

M.A. Ansari Auditorium


