This journal is academic in nature and works towards generating knowledge and influencing viable strategies related to the process of women's empowerment, facilitating an interactive platform for academicians, grassroots activists, students and other civil society agents to know about the struggles to build solidarity and to exchange experiences, activities and interventions. It reaches diverse segments of society with valuable insights on specific women's issues and has widespread acceptability from its readers and contributors.

Women's Link carries articles on women's lives from all dimensions i.e. rights, violence, religious laws and ideological set-ups, education, health, participation in economic, political and social realms, impact of science and technology and the implications of privatization, globalization and liberalization. The compendium of articles attempts to broaden the base and delineate the framework of analysis in the hope of evolving critical perspective to understand the position of women in today's society.

Initially, the journal was published quarterly by the Indian Social Institute, New Delhi. In April 2017, publication was taken over by the Sarojini Naidu Centre for Women's Studies, Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), until July-August 2020. The journal was then briefly shifted to the Department of English, JMI, before returning to its original publication home, the Sarojini Naidu Centre for Women's Studies, in October 2024. The journal is now published bi-annually, releasing issues every January and July
