The Majlis (AC) deliberated on the proposed amendment in respect of UGC Non-NET fellowship recovery and its discontinuation in case a scholar registered for Ph.D. program wishes his/her admission cancelled at any stage or the scholar fails in any of the Examination related to the M.Phil./Ph.D. program in the relevant Ordinances.

After detailed deliberation, the Majlis (AC) resolved to examine it again by a small Committee with clearly defined terms of reference. The report and the consequent amendment will be placed before the Academic Council for its consideration again.

**Recommendations of Board of Studies, Department of Educational Studies, Faculty Committee (Faculty of Education) regarding the proposal of University of Delhi to jointly offer Master's Degree in Mathematics Education.**



**Consideration on the admission policy of the sports persons in the University.**

The Majlis (AC) was apprised that in order to give an impetus to sports persons in the country, the Jamia Millia Islamia is following a policy of providing admissions in certain notified courses to outstanding sports persons. Para (b) of Chapter 7 of the Prospectus for the academic year 2012-13 mandates that no admissions in the Sports category shall be provided in the Faculty of Engineering & Technology, Faculty of Architecture & Ekistics, and Faculty of Dentistry. The Academic Council has been enabled, under the said Para, to prescribe such other courses in which admissions under the Sports category may not be granted in the University.

It was also informed that for the academic session 2012-13 four applicants had been identified under the Sports category for admissions in various courses of the AJK Mass Communication Research Centre. However, the Director of the Centre has expressed reservations that a highly professional courses like the M.A. in Mass Communication/M.A. in Convergent Journalism should not be entertaining admissions in the Sports category. According to him, the Course is demanding and absolute focal attention is needed to accomplish the same. The practical exercises are substantial part of the courses and these are carried out in groups. Absence of any of the group members either due to engagement in sports activities or otherwise adversely affects the performance of the group as a whole. On careful consideration and following consultations with the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, the Registrar, the Director, AJK MCRC and others concerned, the Vice-Chancellor has taken the decision to exclude courses of the AJK Mass Communication Research Centre from the ambit of the Sports category.

While two applicants who have claimed admission under the Sports category in various courses of the AJK Mass Communication Research Centre have been counseled to take up alternate courses of their choice, one Ms. Bhavna Singh has filed a Writ Petition in the High Court of Delhi which is pending adjudication. It is material to state that Ms. Bhavna Singh has also been offered to take up an alternate course of her choice in the University, to which she has resisted.

The Majlis (AC) endorsed the above decision taken by the Vice-Chancellor to exclude courses of AJK MCRC from the ambit of the Sports Category.

**9.4 Setting up of examination papers in three languages namely Urdu, Hindi and English.**


