THIS MEMORANDUM OF UDERSTANDING IS SIGNED BETWEEN:

Jamia Millia Islamia, a Central University created by an enactment of the Parliament of India (i.e. the Jamia Millia Islamia Act, 1988) and is a body corporate with a perpetual succession and a common seal (acting through its Registrar Prof SM Sajid)

The Sciences-Po Toulouse, France

Statuatory Alert:

AND WHEREAS it is the statutory object of the Jamia Millia Islamia University to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional, research and extension facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit and it shall endeavor to provide to students and teachers the necessary atmosphere and facilities for the promotion of:

- (i) Innovations in education leading to restructuring of courses, new methods of teaching and learning and integral development of personality.
- (ii) Studies in various disciplines.
- (iii) Inter disciplinary studies.
- (iv) National integration, secularism and international under-standing.

NOW THEREFORE the Jamia Millia Islamia and Sciences-Po Toulouse have intended, agreed and consented to following terms and deeds in pursuance of a common intent to promote and develop the study of mutual interest.

1 FIELD OF COOPERATION:

- (a) Both the institutions shall evolve a mutually acceptable schedule to develop programme, hold seminars and exchange visits.
- (b) The said academic interaction and intellectual assimilation may include-
 - Faculty/Staff development and exchange;
 - (ii) Exchange of Students;
 - (iii) Seminars, research, conferences and workshops;
 - (iv) Collaborations in the sharing of academic datas, scientific information, intellectual property, articles and publications;
 - (v) Advice surgeries, placements and executive training;

2. EXCHANGE OF STUDENTS/TEACHERS

- (a) Reciprocal arrangements based and mutually acceptable terms shall be accomplished to give and impetus to collaborative research and joint projects. Teachers, researchers, guides and student of both the institutions shall be encouraged to work in tandem in the laboratories, workshops, faculties and departments of both the institutions.
- (b) Each institution agrees to nominate students in good academic standing for participation in this exchange. A maximum of 3 students per semester may be exchanged by each

institution annually and on a reciprocal basis. Additional students may participate if mutually agreed upon in writing by the two institutions. A balance of incoming and outgoing exchange participants should be maintained over a period of 5 years. Students shall be enrolled generally as exchange students at the host institution, with the same rights and privileges of regular students. Exchange students will be subject to the rules and regulations of the host institution. Likewise that will be subject to the academic regulations of their home institution during the period of exchange. Exchange students will be nominated and selected by the home institution. The home institution shall provide written notification of the names of the students and other relevant information regarding academic records. An exchange student will be liable for the payment of tuition fees and registration fees at the home institution only. The exchange student will have to pay only mandatory social security and health costs (amounting to approximately 200 euros at Sciences-Po Toulouse (liable to change according to government regulations) and library access along with student union card). The student will be responsible for costs related to travel, books, subsistence and accommodation expenses.

3. MISCELLANEOUS:

- (a) The details for the efficacious implementations of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be jointly worked out on mutually acceptable terms within the parameters of the policies, rules and regulations of both the institutions.
- (b) The parties to this Memorandum may, by mutual consent, add modify, amend, delete, review or revise any term(s) and condition (s) of this Agreement.
- (c) The intent and implementation of this Memorandum is SUBJECT to the policies of the respective States (in case of international agreements) and the laws of the land.
- (d) This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in force for period of 3 years from the date of its signature and seal, and may be terminated by either side by giving a six months Notice to that effect in writing However, notwithstanding the Notice of the intent to terminate the Memorandum, all rights, obligations and corresponding duties flowing and subsisting therein shall be respected and mandated till the finalisation and accomplishment thereof.
- (e) The parties to this memorandum of Understanding undertake to treat as "confidential and privileged" information of the other institution which is so classified in advance. The terms of Confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.
- (f) This Memorandum of Understanding shall require the ratification of the competent academic/ executive body of both the institution.
